About the Center for Creativity

What is the Center for Creativity (CfC)?

The Center for Creativity (CfC) is working to create a dedicated visual and performing arts center in San Mateo County. It is powered by grassroots efforts and community organizing, bringing together local residents, artists, city leaders and organizations to create a vibrant hub for creativity. The center seeks to support the arts, foster collaboration, and provide opportunities for creative expression and cultural enrichment throughout the region.

Is the Center for Creativity at 501C(3) Nonprofit?

The *Center for Creativity* operates under the fiscal sponsorship of <u>Casa Circulo Cultural</u>, which is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit. Casa Circulo Cultural's Federal Tax ID Number is 47-4071542.

What is the vision and mission of the Center for Creativity?

- **Vision**: Our vision is for **San Mateo County** to be a vibrant, connected community driven by engagement with the arts. We aim to create a space where creativity thrives, bringing people together across all backgrounds.
- Mission: Our mission is to establish an inclusive, accessible, and innovative arts
 center that nurtures creativity, strengthens community bonds, and empowers individuals
 to experience, create, and connect through the arts.

What is the long-term goal of the Center for Creativity?

The long-term goal of the Center for Creativity (CfC) is to create and build a permanent visual and performing arts center in San Mateo County. This arts center will serve as a lasting space for artistic expression, community engagement, and cultural development, providing a dedicated hub for creativity and the arts in the region.

Who are the people and organizations leading the efforts of the Center for Creativity?

In 2022, we established a formal Steering Committee consisting of local artists and community leaders to conduct research, develop plans, and rally support for a permanent Center for Creativity. A complete list of our volunteer team, supporters and partners can be <u>found here</u>.

What is the history of the Center for Creativity (CfC)?

The **Center for Creativity (CfC)** has a rich history that began with a vision to create a permanent arts center in San Mateo County. The journey started in **2010** with the formation of

ARTS RWC, a collective of artists, art advocates, organizations, and civic leaders dedicated to advancing Redwood City as a vibrant arts community.

In **2022**, our Steering Committee engaged with civic leaders, raised funds, and completed a **feasibility study** to assess the community's needs for a permanent arts center. The study aimed to help shape decisions about the center's activities, location, size, and operations.

By **2023**, the feasibility study was completed, and the Steering Committee began actively sharing the results with the community and rallying support for the project. Throughout this process, numerous **community partners** have become involved, helping to advance the effort toward building a permanent arts center in the region.

What did the Feasibility Study uncover?

The **feasibility study** for the **Center for Creativity (CFC)** provided key insights into the community's needs and the potential impact of a permanent arts center. Here are some of the key findings:

1. Strong Community Support:

 83% of adult respondents from a community survey believe there is a need for an arts center in the area and agree that it would enhance the quality of life for the community.

2. Need for Accessible, Affordable Space:

 Artists and arts organizations in and around Redwood City have expressed a strong, documented need for affordable and dedicated spaces where they can create, teach, learn, exhibit, rehearse, and perform.

3. Ideal Facility Design (once a permanent art center is built):

- The study identified an ideal facility to meet the community's needs, which would include:
 - A large, flexible multi-purpose performing arts room
 - Multiple visual art studios, classrooms, and shared workspaces
 - Suitable storage and office spaces
 - Totaling approximately **30,000 square feet**.

The Next Phase for Center for Creativity

The Center for Creativity is starting with a proof-of-concept space instead of a permanent visual and performing arts center due to the high costs involved in establishing a permanent facility. City and county leadership want to first assess the potential impact of such a space before committing to long-term funding.

The proof-of-concept space at Hotel Sequoia in Redwood City, CA allows the community to experience the benefits of an arts hub on a smaller scale, helping to build support and demonstrate its value before pursuing larger, more costly investments in a permanent center. Starting small provides a manageable way to gauge interest and secure the necessary funding for future growth.

Why is the Center for Creativity opening at Hotel Sequoia in 2025?

The Center for Creativity will occupy the **historic Hotel Sequoia** in downtown **Redwood City** as a two-year temporary space. Hotel Sequoia has been closed to the public for more than 50 years and will now be transformed into a vibrant arts and cultural hub. This collaboration allows us to revitalize this important historic landmark while contributing to the cultural and economic vitality of the community.

The hotel team is committed to supporting the arts and culture in San Mateo County, and this partnership with the Center for Creativity allows the arts to play a central role in the revitalization of downtown Redwood City.

What is the history of Hotel Sequoia?

Hotel Sequoia, a landmark building in **downtown Redwood City**, has been closed to the public for over five decades. It is part of the city's rich history and will now play an important role in its cultural future. The collaboration between the Hotel Sequoia team and the Center for Creativity is an exciting opportunity to breathe new life into the building, honoring its legacy while launching a new era of arts and culture in the region.

How will the Center for Creativity transform Hotel Sequoia?

The **rotunda** and **downstairs sections** of Hotel Sequoia will be repurposed into a thriving arts hub. These historic spaces will host a variety of artistic programs, performances, and community events, revitalizing the heart of downtown Redwood City and showcasing its cultural potential.

This transformation marks a key milestone in both the hotel's redevelopment and the broader vision for arts and culture in San Mateo County.

What will happen to Hotel Sequoia after 2026?

The Center for Creativity will be located in the **historic Hotel Sequoia** at the end of Broadway in **downtown Redwood City**, California. CfC will occupy the rotunda and lower levels of the building, making it a unique and vibrant venue for arts and culture.

Will there be parking available at Hotel Sequoia?

Downtown Redwood City has plenty of street parking and nearby lots which require a fee located near the hotel. There are also public transportation options nearby, and we encourage attendees to take advantage of these eco-friendly options when possible.
